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Dato Seri Laila Jasa Dr Nagamuttu Ravindranathan is a Maxillofacial, Facial Plastic and Reconstructive surgeon. He has been the Chief Cleft Surgeon in Brunei since March 1993 and has provided a statewide cleft service. In South East Asia, amongst the Maxillofacial Surgeons, he was pioneering cleft surgery since early 1988. In 1989, he set up the cleft service for Region II at the Cagayan Valley Sanitarium Hospital until 2010, as an entirely charitable service for the Social Economic Development Assistance Foundation of Isabela(SEDIFI). He graduated from St. Georges Hospital Medical School in London and had his Plastic and Reconstructive Surgery training under Mr. David L Harris, former Chief of Plastic and Reconstructive surgery at the Derriford Hospital, Plymouth, United Kingdom who was the cleft lead surgeon. He had also worked as first assistant to the Late Mr. R. Sundaraion, Plastic and Reconstructive surgeon in Singapore. He was a qualified Orthodontist prior to undertaking his surgical training from the Eastman Hospital, London. He had his Maxillofacial training through rotating training posts under Professor Robert Ord (now in USA), Late Mr. Norman Rowe, Late Mr. Ian Heslop and Professor Gordon Seward in UK. He was a Fellow at The Johns Hopkins Medical Institutions USA in Head and Neck / Skull Base Surgery under Late Dr. Daryl Jaques and Late Dr. Donald Tilghman, and Distinguished Service Professor, Harvey Cushing Professor of Neurosurgery, and Dr. Donlin Long for 18 months. He was also a trainee of Late Professor Gerald Westbury, in the proprietorial surgical unit at the Royal Marsden Cancer Hospital, London, UK.

His special interest in Cleft Craft is Cleft Rhinoplasty and he is dedicated to holistic care from birth to adulthood for children born with a Cleft deformities.
